6. Modern Israel Defiles the Covenant of Righteousness and Justice ...



Israel is to be a prototype, of "righteousness and justice (Genesis 12:3)." God cares as much how people relate to Him as how people relate with each other and the other. Abraham, "the father of a multitude of nations," is the father of "righteousness and justice."

"For I have chosen him – God called Abraham "out of" his country, his family, and his father's house (Genesis 12:1) –, that he may command his children and his household after him to keep the way of the Lord by doing righteousness and justice, so that the Lord may bring to Abraham what he has promised him" (Genesis 18:19, ESV).

Abraham is called to spearhead God's passion for justice! And from Abraham's seed comes the people of Israel. God calls Israel into existence to become a "light among nations," finding ultimate embodiment and expression in Jesus Christ among Jews and Gentiles. The Apostle Peter: "You are the heirs of the prophets and of the covenant God made with your fathers. He said to Abraham, 'Through your offspring all the peoples on earth will be blessed'" (Acts 3:25, NIV).

Those original words, "In you all nations of the earth shall be blessed" (Genesis 12:3), are passed down from generation to generation to remind us of our purpose as God's people.

It means embracing biblical justice that acknowledges—not merely in theory, but in practice—that people are created in God's image and are infinitely valuable.

Isn't Modern Israel, like all gentiles, accountable to the Original Covenant, the Covenant of Righteousness and Justice? Reluctance and rejection of "the Word of the Lord" has started with the dance around the golden calf. It is still going on. Israel today is even more corrupt than the Israel of 2,000 years ago. Many Christians, myopically entranced in their dogmas, are

dancing with pagans around a golden calf; unwittingly aiding and abetting the Neo-Party of the Pharisees.
